- Organisation of **ANETREC summer school**, 4-11 September 2022, Bitola, North Macedonia,
- Adoption of **MARIBOR DECLARATION - PROMOTING RECONCILIATION AND REGIONAL COOPERATION IN THE WESTERN BALKANS AS ESSENTIAL PRECONDITIONS FOR THE EFFECTIVE EUROPEAN INTEGRATION OF THE REGION** at the project concluding conference in September 2023 in Maribor, Slovenia.
